PURPOSE OF PROJECT

The Saskatchewan Avenue Bridge over Omand's Creek is at the end of its service life.

- The load carrying capacity of the structure is limited.
- The bridge does not meet modern roadside safety standards.
- The sidewalk over the bridge is narrow.
- The creek channel needs hydraulic upgrading and erosion protection.

The purpose of this project (which will start in January 2016) is to replace the timber bridge structure, to improve its strength, safety and functionality. The new structure is expected to last at least 75 years.












SITE LOCATION









Proposed Construction


- 1. Demolish and dispose of existing bridge.
- 2. Place rock rip-rap in creek channel and on embankment slopes.
- 3. Construct new bridge abutment foundations.
- 4. Construct new cast-in-place single span concrete bridge deck.
- 5. Construct new sidewalks and barrier rail on bridge.
- 6. Resurface bridge approach roadway immediately east and west of bridge.
- 7. Construction work accommodates possible future right turn lane and cycle track along Empress Street.


PLAN VIEW

PROPOSED BRIDGE CROSS-SECTION








Traffic Management

- Bridge crossing will be closed to all traffic during construction. (January - May 2016)
- Empress Street and its westbound connection to Saskatchewan Avenue will remain open during construction.
- Alternate routes include Dublin Avenue and Sargent Avenue via St. James Street.
- Midland Street will be local access only from Notre Dame Avenue.
