CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: Resident / Businesses on Dublin Avenue and St. James Street

RE: Replacement of the Dublin Avenue Bridge over Omand's Creek and Associated Regional Street Improvements

Please be advised that construction on this project will begin in January 2020. This project includes replacement of the Dublin Avenue Bridge at Omand's Creek, pavement reconstruction of Dublin Avenue from St. James Street to Midland Street, and pavement rehabilitation of St James Street from Saskatchewan Avenue to Notre Dame Avenue.

Phase 1 – Dublin Bridge Replacement (Winter 2020)

Construction start: December 31, 2019 (full closure of Dublin Avenue at the bridge)
Bridge completed and reopened to traffic in May 2020

Phase 1 starts on **December 31, 2019** and involves **full closure of eastbound and westbound lanes and sidewalks** of Dublin Avenue at the bridge over Omand's Creek, until **May 2020**.

During this closure, vehicles, pedestrians, Winnipeg Transit, and emergency services will not have access over the bridge. Access to the area will be via Orange Street, Bangor Avenue and St. James Street.

Affected bus stops will be relocated, and Transit service will be rerouted. Local access to businesses on Dublin Avenue will be maintained via St. James Street (for access to Dublin Avenue west of the closure) and via Notre Dame Avenue / Midland Street (for access to Dublin Avenue east of the closure).

Phase 2 – Regional Street Roadwork (Summer 2020)

Construction start: May 2020
Construction end: September 2020

Phase 2 of this project will start in mid-May 2020 and includes:

- Pavement reconstruction of Dublin Avenue between St. James Street and Midland Street
- Pavement rehabilitation of St. James Street from Saskatchewan Avenue to Notre Dame Avenue

Public Works
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The existing road and sidewalks on Dublin Avenue will be completely removed, and new pavement will be constructed. The existing drainage sewers will be repaired where necessary. During construction, traffic on Dublin Avenue **will be permitted in the westbound direction only**.

The St. James Street roadwork includes reconstruction of the existing sidewalks and rehabilitation of the existing pavement. A new sidewalk will be built on the east side of St. James Street. During construction, traffic on St. James Street will be reduced to **one lane each both northbound and southbound**.

Pedestrian and emergency access to residences and business will be maintained, although at times pedestrians may be required to temporarily use alternate access points.
