CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: Resident / Businesses on Dublin Avenue and St. James Street

RE: Replacement of the Dublin Avenue Bridge over Omand's Creek and Associated Regional Street Improvements

We understand that now is a time of much uncertainty but want to assure you we are proceeding on the assumption that construction season will continue. We will be using alternate means of communication to ensure that discussions which would have formerly taken place in-person still occur. If you anticipate being away from your business and/or mailbox for an extended period of time, please contact us with an alternative address, phone number, and email at which we can reach you leading up to and during construction.

Please be advised that the Dublin Avenue bridge over Omand's Creek will open to one lane of traffic on May 4, 2020 and the roadwork will commence in May 2020.

Roadwork Construction start:	May 2020
Total Duration:	Roadworks completed in fall 2020
Impacted streets and intersections:	Dublin Avenue from St. James Street to Notre Dame Avenue and St. James Street from Saskatchewan Avenue to Notre Dame Avenue

We wish to advise you that the above bridge replacement and street improvement project is planned for Summer 2020 (**start date of approximately the middle of May**). This project will be completed in stages throughout the entirety of the 2020 construction season and will be **completed in fall 2020**.

Major construction elements include: reconstruction of Dublin Avenue; major rehabilitation of St James Street from Saskatchewan Avenue to Dublin Avenue; and asphalt resurfacing on St. James Street north of Dublin Avenue. A new sidewalk will be construction along the east side of St. James Street within the project limits.

As part of the Dublin Avenue roadworks the existing road and sidewalks will be completely removed, and a new road structure will be constructed. The road will be a new concrete pavement with new curbs and sidewalks. The existing drainage sewers will be repaired where necessary. Dublin Avenue will be reconstructed half at a time and **traffic will only be permitted in the westbound direction**.

St. James Street construction work will include reconstruction of the existing sidewalks and installing yellow detectable tiles and paving stone bands to improve accessibility. The existing asphalt will be removed, and some pavement joints will be repaired. Most of the curbs will be replaced. A thick layer of asphalt will be placed on top of the repaired concrete to improve drainage, prolong the life span of the pavement and make it smooth. St. James Street will be constructed half at a time and **will maintain one lane northbound and one lane southbound at all times.**

Pedestrian access as well as emergency access to residences and business will be maintained throughout, although pedestrian circulation may be disrupted at times due to sidewalk repairs.
