Project Background

In 2012, federal, provincial and municipal officials announced that the Plessis Road Underpass was approved for joint funding by the three levels of government, with a budget of \$77 million.

Traffic is regularly restricted by passing trains causing congestion. The development of the Plessis Underpass will separate trains from motor vehicles, bicycles and pedestrians, making the area safer and more efficient for all modes of transportation.

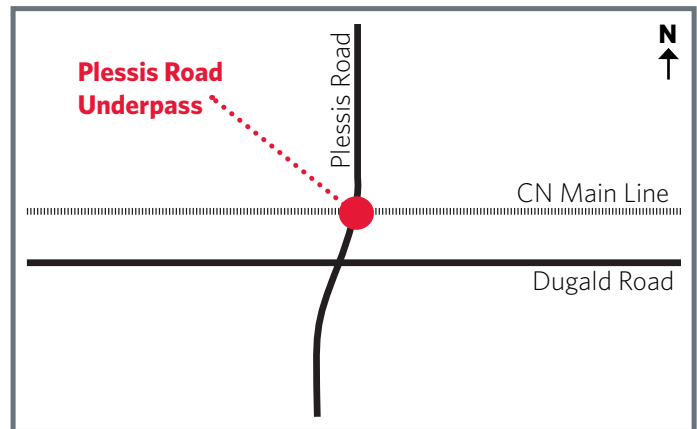


Project Highlights

The Project will include an underpass of the CN Rail line. The underpass is to be located north of the Plessis Road and Dugald Road intersection. Other components of the project will include:

- Land drainage system improvements.
- Active Transportation facilities.
- Roadway improvements on Plessis Road, upgrading from two lanes to four lanes divided between Dugald Road and Pandora Avenue.
- Relocation of utilities, including watermains, sewers, fibre optic cables, gas mains, distribution poles, street lights and electrical lines.
- Relocation of oil pipelines.

Construction is to begin in the spring and is scheduled for completion by the end of 2014.
