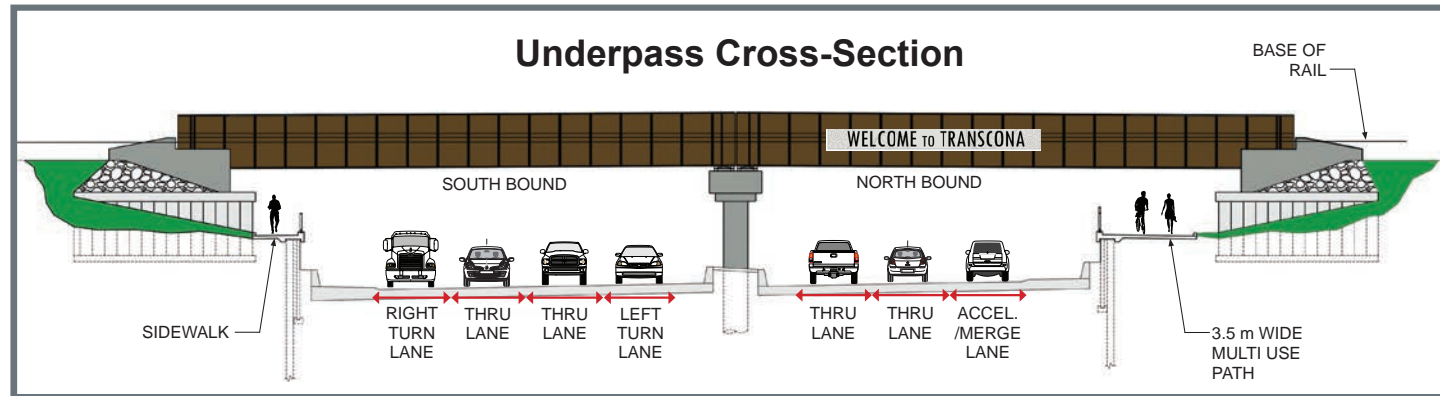

Proposed Signage and Public Art

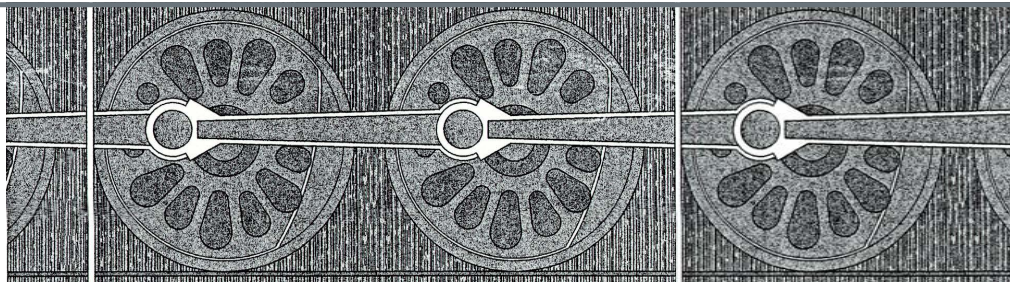

Construction Update

Plessis Road has been closed between Dugald Road and Kernaghan Avenue since July 28, 2013. Currently, the rail detour, pumping station, road work and underground construction are underway. It is expected that some residents will experience short disruptions to water services during this time, notices will be delivered prior to any disruption. If the water interruption is more than one day a temporary supply will be made available. The City anticipates that Plessis Road will fully re-open to traffic on September 1, 2015 and construction is expected to be complete by September 15, 2015.

Project Moving Forward

Traffic Calming and Detouring Measures

We ask motorists to avoid using Bournais Drive as a detour. The City continues to monitor traffic in the area, and the following measures have been implemented to address pedestrian safety in the vicinity of Bernie Wolfe Community School:

- Enhanced traffic enforcement
- Speed management
- Signage
- New traffic calming measures
- Realignment of Bournais Drive sidewalk at Rougeau Avenue to increase visibility and safety

Additional adult crossing guards at Bernie Wolfe Community School are being paid for by the City of Winnipeg to assist with pedestrian safety. The City has reduced the speed limit on Pandora Avenue East between Ravenhurst Street and Redonda Street from 70 to 60 km/hr. The City also has suspended the diamond lanes on Regent Avenue to assist with higher traffic volumes and retimed signals.



The City recognizes that the extended closure of Plessis Road may cause you some inconvenience and apologizes for this. Thank you for your patience.
